# The Creels Adventures in Mekong Land - Christmas 2023

Greetings and Merry Christmas from Phnom Penh, Cambodia! We hope you had a good Thanksgiving celebration and are enjoying this holiday season. As we reflect on the birth of our Savior in this Advent season, let us not forget that there are still 3.4 billion people around the world who have still not heard the story of Jesus' birth, life, death, and resurrection. Even here in Cambodia, we often meet people who have never heard about Jesus. Thanksgiving and Christmas are not even officially recognized holidays in Cambodia.

Bringing the Good News of salvation through Jesus Christ "until all have heard" is Far East Broadcasting Company's mission. This is the message that FEBC has been proclaiming for the past 78 years via radio and internet-based media. FEBC operates in 50 countries, broadcasting in 152 languages, using 260 radio stations and transmitters. On average, we receive 150 million listener engagements each year. Here in Cambodia, where Buddhism is the predominant religion, God is using FEBC's broadcasts to introduce many to Christ and help them

grow in their faith. Currently, FEBC broadcasts the Good News to listeners throughout the country using two FM radio stations, shortwave broadcasts from the Philippines, social media, and internet streaming.

Thank you for your prayers as we continue to adjust to life in Cambodia. We recently completed our second eight-week round of Khmer language studies. Learning another language at our ages is difficult, but with the Lord's help, we are making progress. Of course, learning the culture can also be challenging, but it is also rewarding as we learn how to better understand and relate to the Khmer people.

On October 18-19, FEBC Cambodia in partnership with SANSA Finland hosted the Cambodia Christian Family Conference in the province of Siem Reap.
